**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO VACATE DEFAULT BRIEFING DEADLINES
AND STAY PROCEEDINGS FOR 60 DAYS**

This matter comes before the Court on the Parties' Motion to Vacate Default Briefing Deadlines and Stay Proceedings for 60 Days. Having considered the Parties' motion, the Court will grant the motion for good cause shown.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, All proceedings in the above-captioned litigation are stayed until May 10, 2026.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, the default briefing deadlines pursuant to Local Civil Rule 83.6(c) are hereby vacated.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, Respondents shall promptly notify the Court if BLM changes

its intention not to conduct a wild horse gather pursuant to the challenged decision during the current fiscal year. Any such notification shall be provided at least 60 days before any proposed gather is scheduled to occur.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED, no later than May 10, 2026, the Parties will file a joint status report updating the Court on the status of the case and advising the Court whether it is necessary to extend the stay or proposing next steps for proceedings in the case.
